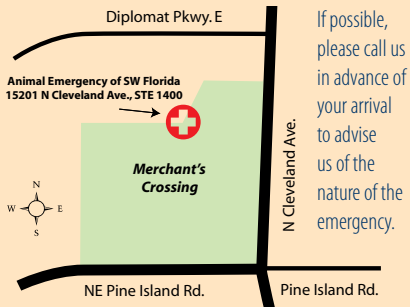

Continued Care and Patient Transfer –

All patients requiring ongoing care following emergency services must be transferred to their family veterinarian between 6:30am and 7:30am the next business day. All follow-up care, such as suture and drain removals, must be performed by your family veterinarian. If you do not have a regular veterinarian, we will be happy to recommend one to you.

Emergency Care Fees

Emergency care can be very costly, reflecting the state-of-the-art facilities and professional staff needed to provide emergency and critical care. Each admission involves an emergency office call, which includes the emergency fee and examination. Following the examination, treatment options will be discussed and a health care plan will be provided for the cost of any additional veterinary services.



You are encouraged to discuss any fees and treatment options with our professional staff. A deposit based on the cost of the health care plan will be required for any animal being admitted to the hospital. **Payment in full is required at the time of discharge.** We accept Visa, MasterCard, Discover, CareCredit® and cash. Personal checks are accepted with check approval and proper identification.
